- Can purchase a 5-game package for \$680 after September 15.
- Golf Canada \$45
- Monthly Capital Fee \$50
- There is no cash or credit value to each round and no rounds may be carried over to the next season or transferred to another member.
- **Cannot participate in some competitive golf events sanctioned by the Club, including Intersectional and women's Interclub Teams, Club Championships and some other competitive events.**

## ASSOCIATE MEMBERS 15\* *reserved for existing members only* and Abolished Categories Associate 5, 10\* & 25

- Limited number of rounds per year.
- Every tee time after 5 p.m. during the week and weekends after 3 p.m. will be treated as 9 holes. \*
- No restrictions on day or time of play.
- Cannot play as a guest after using their allocated number of rounds.
- Can purchase a 5-game package for \$680 after September 15.
- Golf Canada \$45
- Monthly Capital Fee \$50
- There is no cash or credit value to each round and no rounds may be carried over to the next season or transferred to another member.
- **Cannot participate in some competitive golf events sanctioned by the Club, including Intersectional and women's Interclub Teams, Club Championships and some other competitive events.**

## INTERMEDIATE C1, C2 and C3

- No tee time restrictions.
- Golf Canada included.
- Golf Services included.
- Monthly Capital Fee \$50

## INTERMEDIATE A1, A2, B1 & B2 (19 to 29 years old)

- Weekends: can play after 11 a.m.
- Can pay the annual dues of C1 category to have no tee time restrictions.
- Monthly Capital Fee \$50

## SENIOR RESTRICTED MEMBERS / SENIOR RESTRICTED SPOUSES - Abolished

- Members must be 75 years of age or older on January 1.
- Monthly Capital Fee \$50

Restrictions on day or time of play:

- Monday and Thursday: no restrictions.
- Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday: play before 1 p.m. unless participating as a paid member in the Wednesday men's league or Tuesday women's league.
- Weekends and holidays: play after 12 p.m. unless participating in the Women's Weekenders' event.

## CORPORATE MEMBERS

- Playing privileges for up to four individuals from the company, designated annually by the company and whose employed and supported by documentation. A package of rounds that may be used by your designated members and their guests. (Note: A fee of \$250 is applicable to change a designated member during the calendar year).
- Cannot play 9-hole.
- Golf services are included for the primary member. For the other members, the cost is \$500 (club cleaning & storage and locker with all services).
- Limit on the number of rounds of golf per year per category (40, 60, 80 or 100 games).
- There is no cash or credit value to each round and no rounds may be carried over to the next season or transferred to another member.
- Monthly Capital Fee \$50 per member

### Restrictions on day or time of play:

- Weekdays: no restrictions.
- Weekends and holidays: may play after 1 p.m.
- Golf Canada Gold Card for first designate, \$45 for each subsequent designate.
- Can participate in all club social events.
- Can participate in non-competitive golf events, including men's and women's leagues (upon payment of the relevant fees), June Classic, Men's and Women's Member-Guest Days, Rivermead Cup Day, Ernie Harsh, Centennial Classic and Fall Classic. Women may participate in most Thursday and Saturday women's golf activities.
- **Cannot participate in competitive golf events sanctioned by the Club, including Intersectional and women's Interclub Teams, Club Championships and some other competitive events.**

## JUNIOR CATEGORIES (all categories) - Reserved for children and grandchildren of golfing members.

### Gold Golf Canada Card: Included but on request only.

#### Pre-junior (7 to 9 years old as of January 1)

- Reserved for children and grandchildren of golfing members of Rivermead Golf Club.
- Must be always accompanied on the golf course by the parent or grandparent golfing member.
- Must tee off from the forward (black) tees on Par 3s, from the 150-yard marker on Par 4s and from the 200-yard marker on Par 5s unless the Head Professional approves play from the forward (black) tees.

### Restrictions on day and time of play:

- Weekdays: after 5 p.m.
- Weekends and Statutory Holidays: after 3 p.m.

#### Pre-junior Elite (7 to 9 years old as of January 1)

- Must have an established handicap
- Must have been approved by the Head Professional.
- Reserved for children and grandchildren of golfing members.
- The Pre-juniors must always be accompanied on the golf course by the parent or grandparent golfing member.
- Must tee off from the forward (black) tees on Par 3s, from the 150-yard marker on Par 4s and from the 200-yard marker on Par 5s unless the Head Professional approves play from the forward (black) tees.

### Restrictions on day and time of play:

- Weekdays: before noon and after 2 p.m. (no play on Wednesdays after noon)
- Weekends and Statutory Holidays: after 1 p.m.

#### Beginners (10 to 18 years old as of January 1)

- Beginners who do not yet have a handicap.
- Must always play with a playing member.

### Restrictions on day and time of play:

- Weekdays: after 4 p.m.
- Weekends and Statutory Holidays: after 2 p.m.

### **Juniors (10 to 18 years old as of January 1)**

- Must have an established handicap.
- Juniors may play with other juniors during the appropriate times.

#### Restrictions on day and time of play:

- Weekdays: before noon and after 2 p.m. (no play on Wednesdays after noon)
- Weekends and Statutory Holidays: after 1 p.m.

### **Class A Juniors (10 to 18 years old as of January 1)**

- Weekends: can play after 11 a.m.
  - Must have been approved by the Head Professional.
  - Boys: with handicap factors of 8.6 or less.
  - Girls: with handicap factors of 18.4 or less.
1. Rivermead must be their home course, and they must play an active role in Rivermead's junior program. *Junior A category members must provide 4 days of volunteer service during the junior summer camps or weekly clinics each year while in this category.*

### **SABBATICAL CATEGORY**

- This category applies to existing members who wish to leave the Club while retaining their action and the right to return to the full privileges golfer category without being subject to the waiting list.
- \$1,085 / year
- No golf privileges
- Continue to pay the initiation fee if it is in effect.

### **SOCIAL MEMBERS**

May play up to a maximum of five rounds of golf per year as a guest of a golfing member upon payment of a guest fee. May only use practice facility up to five days per year and only on the same day that a guest fee has been paid.

### **NON-RESIDENT MEMBERS – Reserved for existing members only**

- The main residence and place of employment of non-resident members must be at least 125 kilometres from the Rivermead Golf Club.
- May play a total of 10 rounds of golf at Rivermead. Six of those rounds of golf per year will be at no charge and the additional four rounds of golf per year will be at the prevailing guest fee rate.
- May only use practice facility up to 10 days per year and only on the same day as one of the six included rounds or four rounds paying a guest fee.
